PARISH TAXI SCHEME FOR RESIDENTS OF LEZANT PARISH ONLY

The parish council subsidy for the taxi scheme is now £4 per trip, return £4 each way. The fares charged by Launceston Taxis are as below. As a resident of Lezant Parish, you are entitled to a subsidy of £4.00 for any taxi journey at any time, so long as a taxi is available. To take advantage of the scheme the taxi must be prebooked through Launceston Taxis on 07340 813434. The taxi driver will have a form that he will complete. You sign the form and pay the reduced rate to the driver. Please note that the single fares quoted below are for guidance only, if you live outside one of the villages the fare may differ slightly:

Lezant £9.00	Subsidy £4.00	You pay £5.00
Tregada £9.00		You pay £5.00
Trekenner £10.00		You pay £6.00
Trekelland £9.00		You pay £5.00
Trebullett £10.00		You pay £6.00
Treburley £10.00		You pay £6.00
Rezare £10.50		You pay £6.50

For example, a return journey from Treburley to Launceston will cost £12 in total. The Parish Council would encourage all residents to use the taxi whenever possible although it is appreciated that a taxi is not always available. Pre-booking the day before can sometimes help. Remember, the taxi cannot be used on a regular basis for commuting between home and work, nor as a school-run vehicle.

TESCO stores in the SW including Launceston have added an extra in store collection alongside their carrier bags recycling cage. The additional cage is for "soft" plastics, ie not hard/rigid plastic, so this includes crinkly plastic from:

- some fruits n veg, salad items, peppers, tomatoes, celery, spinach, apples
- film off punnets of fruit and trays of veg & meat, the tray can go in your kerbside recycling
- sleeves and film lids off yoghurt pots, the pots can go in your kerbside recycling
- packets from sauces, coffee, tea, noodles, rice & pasta
- cereals, muesli, granola & oats, dried fruit, sugar in plastic bags
- bread rolls, crumpets, thins & naan packaging
- pretty much all the food packaging that **RECYCLING FOR CHARITY** can not take...

The cages are located in the lobby just before the exit in the Launceston store Stretchy plastic can be recycled with carrier bags and include

- shrink wrap from cans
- bubblewrap,
- postal bags
- frozen chips and peas packets
 - spuds and apple bags
- nets from fruit and garlic
- carrier bags.

Every little helps

News from Trebullett Methodist Church

I write to you the day before we, in the church, celebrate the Ascension of Christ. This is the time when Jesus left this world, after he had risen from the dead, and went to be with our Father in heaven. Jesus had spent forty extraordinary days with his disciples, teaching and preparing them for the time when he would leave them. On that day, they all gathered on the Mount of Olives overlooking Jerusalem. Jesus blessed them and as he spoke the presence of God surrounded him, and he disappeared from their sight. As the disciples looked intently up into the sky, two men asked "Why do you stand here looking into the sky?"

In some ways we all do that don't we? An unexpected experience, a change of events, a death, even a pandemic may stop us in our tracks and we are left stunned and confused by what we should do now. I pray, in whatever experiences you have had whilst we have been in this pandemic, that you have had someone come alongside you and gently encourage you to go forward. We may not feel like it. We may find it hard, but with the support and help of others, we will be able to forge a way through and shape our lives to create a new normal. The disciples went forward and ten days later, at Pentecost, they received the Holy Spirit. They emerged from the place where they were huddled together, strengthened and renewed, so they could spread the gospel to the ends of the earth. From just 12 disciples, the movement of Christianity spread like wildfire throughout the world and continues to this day. The Church may appear to be stopped in its tracks at the moment, like we have seen with most things through this pandemic, but it refuses to sit still. Instead, it forges a way forward and, through the guidance of God's Spirit, begins to shape a new normal.
