"Watching wild life from a kayak."

Rupert Kirkwood has always loved wildlife and is a keen kayaker, who has been able to paddle around the coast. He took 10 years to kayak the south coast and he has clocked up 27,672 miles to date.

He has kayaked in all sorts of weather conditions throughout the year and seen the hump back whale on the east coast of Devon also Oyster catchers were sighted. We were shown footage of the Flying Scotsman travelling along the Teignmouth line, together with grey seals and a young fox among some rocks. He seemed surprised to see Rupert!

He saw pod of common dolphins performing together with a sighting of a giant blue thin tuna, they are the largest tuna species on the planet. Sightings of jelly fish were seen. The most dangerous jelly fish however, are the Man of War. His favourite creek is the Tavistock Estuary especially listening and witnessing the Dawn Chorus. Fresh water birds can be found such as the Grey wagtail.

When kayaking in Fowey juvenile grey seals are seen and they come from the Netherlands.

It takes Rupert four hours to kayak out to Eddystone Lighthouse but once there he is rewarded with Gannets with their 6ft wing span. He has seen a 50ft whale, only 1 or 2 have been seen around the UK, together with 14ft long Dolphins passing by. At Looe harbour he has seen the Red Throated Dyber (Rain Geese as they are known in Scotland) and at the end of Looe Island Grey Seals can be found and under water they are very graceful and balletic!

In Truro, we saw footage of a badger swimming in the sea at the end of the Lizard. Rupert was able to give us all an insight into the wildlife from a kayakers viewpoint!

PARISH TAXI SCHEME FOR RESIDENTS OF LEZANT PARISH ONLY

The parish council subsidy for the taxi scheme is now £4 per trip, return £4 each way. The fares charged by Launceston Taxis are as below. As a resident of Lezant Parish, you are entitled to a subsidy of £4.00 for any taxi journey at any time, so long as a taxi is available. To take advantage of the scheme the taxi must be prebooked through Launceston Taxis on 07340 813434. The taxi driver will have a form that he will complete. You sign the form and pay the reduced rate to the driver. Please note that the single fares quoted below are for guidance only, if you live outside one of the villages the fare may differ slightly:

Tregada £9.00		You pay £5.00
Trekenner £10.00		You pay £6.00
Trekelland £9.00		You pay £5.00
Trebullett £10.00		You pay £6.00

Rezare £10.50		You pay £6.50

For example, a return journey from Treburley to Launceston will cost £12 in total. The Parish Council would encourage all residents to use the taxi whenever possible although it is appreciated that a taxi is not always available. Pre-booking the day before can sometimes help. Remember, the taxi cannot be used on a regular basis for commuting between home and work, nor as a school-run vehicle.

Games by Ruth Burden

Recalling memories of my childhood playground games, I am interested in sharing some and triggering readers' memories who might like to share theirs, perhaps as part of our archive group. At primary school , as well as the usual catch and tag, I spent hours just skipping, playing with hoola hoops, hop scotch, marbles, conkers, when in season. A huge favourite was skipping in together with a large rope, singing 'All in together girls, this fine weather girls' as one of us joined in , then the next and then the next. The game of Jacks was very popular and skilful. One rubber ball and 10 six legged metal objects the size of a small dice were used. The skill to bounce the ball and pick up one Jack before the ball re-bounced in the same hand, to bounce the ball to pick up two before the re-bounce, then three, then four, etc. Oh yes, we used to play the Pick up Sticks game for a while with the little different coloured sticks piled up, and one could only take one without the others moving at all.
