

LEZANT PARISH ARCHIVE GROUP



More than 40 people came to Trebullett Hall on 30 April to enjoy a slide presentation of photos and documents relating to Lezant Parish. The collection of more than 300 items was acquired by the Lezant Archive Group and included pictures of the Parish's hamlets and villages taken early in the last century (courtesy of Roy and Richard Brawn and Callington Heritage Centre), Trebullett Chapel, Lezant Church, Trekenner School and its pupils, the war memorial and its history (courtesy of John Davies), and local families, including the Goodmans and Knights. More recent photos showed people living in the Parish at the Millennium, and one sequence showed life in Lezant in the 1970s – several in the audience recognised their younger selves and contemporaries!

Thanks to David Rogerson for collating the presentation, to Lesley and Jim Buscombe for providing a display of artefacts found through their metaldetecting activities, to Irene Wood for her drawings of some of the older Parish characters (and for collecting the takings!), and to Ruth Burden, Lesley Buscombe, Jo Rider, and Tanya Jonas for organising refreshments.



PARISH TAXI SCHEME—FOR RESIDENTS OF LEZANT PARISH ONLY

If you are a resident of Lezant Parish, you can claim a subsidy for any taxi journey using Launceston Taxis. (Please note: the taxi cannot be used on a regular basis for commuting between home and work, nor as a school-run vehicle.)

From 01 December 2024 the subsidy was increased to £7 per single journey (you can also claim £7 for the return journey, if applicable). Please note this increase will be for a limited time only in order to use up reserves - once the grant is exhausted the subsidy will be lowered.
