ON THE BUSES!

The bus service between Plymouth and Bude running along the A388 through the Parish has long been a lifeline or at least, a convenient way to travel and leave the car at home.



In terms of reducing car usage, thus reducing carbon emissions, it triggered the introduction of a £2 fare for a single journey to make it an even more attractive way to travel. A few months later the Government increased the fare to £3 per trip, which caused some criticism but remained a very cheap option. Those who use the local bus service should be aware that the service between Plymouth and Bude has changed.

The operator, Go Cornwall, has cut the weekday service by about 25% and has also changed the fare structure. What was once a single trip on the No 12 bus has been adjusted to make it 3 separate journeys with a charge of £3 for each section. It breaks down (as do the buses regularly) as Plymouth to Callington, Callington to Launceston, Launceston to Bude. This means the single journey costing £3 for the whole trip on the No 12 now costs £9 each way. On some buses it is necessary to change to a different bus with a new number on it. In other cases, the driver merely changes the number on the bus and you pay again.

The bus numbers running through this new scheme starting with the Plymouth section are 12,76 and 76A. The cynics among us might be prone to think that Go Cornwall has found a crafty way of circumventing the Governments £3 fare policy.


Petitions in local areas such as Callington and Stoke Climsland are ongoing.

TREBURLEY GARAGE - THE END OF AN ERA

People living outside of the Parish can generally locate Treburley if you mention Treburley Garage, the Springer Spaniel pub or perhaps Treburley Social Club.

Sadly, we are about to lose one of our iconic landmarks with the announcement of the closure of Treburley Garage at the end of July.



Set in the heart of the village of Treburley, it has been a saviour for local drivers in need of fuel and repairs.

Last month's Parish Magazine featured 100 years of Lezant W.I. but the Garage is not far behind, being in business for 73 years. It was founded by Thomas Roy Rowe (always known as Roy) in 1952.

However, the story began around 1950 when, having completed his National Service with the Cornwall Light Infantry and doing an Apprenticeship as a mechanic, he had an ambition to work on his own, servicing and repairing vehicles for the local population. Roy married Beryl Gibbons and they moved into what was Treburley Shop. They had a single bay garage built and installed fuel pumps. Roy was employed as a mechanic with J.B. Smith & Sons in Launceston but he started working part-time at the Garage beginning the business of repairs and maintenance whilst Beryl served at the pumps and ran the Shop.

And so began the business of what was to become a truly family affair. It didn't take long for the Garage to gain a good reputation and for Roy to extend the workshop side of the operation. Fast forward to the 1960's and 1970's when, not only had the business expanded, but so had the Rowe family. Roy and Beryl had a daughter, Rosamund, and shortly afterwards a son, Richard.

They may not have known it at the time but the next generation was to assure the future of the Garage for many years to come. During this time Roy increased the staff, employing more mechanics plus an apprentice, Ian Thomas.

Roy took son Richard under his wing and got him into the workshop, learning the trade.

By this time Roy had gained a reputation as an expert when dealing with Classic cars. Customers came from, not only Cornwall and Devon, but from all over the country.



Rosamund joined the team, helping in the busy office with the telephone work, appointments and all the administrative work associated with a growing business. She married Ian Thomas, who, by that time was no longer an Apprentice, but a fully-fledged part of the workforce.

Roy's health deteriorated in the latter years but, even though he took a back seat in the day to day running of the Garage, he was still seen in the workshop helping out and giving advice to customers. His expertise, particularly with vintage and veteran cars will long be remembered. He was not only Roy Of The Rovers but also Roy of the Austins, the Bentleys, the Morgans and Jaguars, etc. .

Ros and Richard have taken the tiller and guided the business to the present day. The Garage will close on July 31st. However, then begins the task of closing down. They will be occupied with decommissioning the fuel tanks and all the Health and Safety issues this brings with it. Mountains of paperwork and paraphernalia to sort out and resolve.

Richard has a few projects to finish so it may be some while before they can put their feet up and kiss it all goodbye. For the rest of us it will be goodbye to Treburley Garage on July 31st.

4 INGREDIENT CRUFFIN RECIPE

350° F 170° C Gas Mark 4

25mins

3 x Crescent roll dough (croissant in a tube)

Butter softened

5 tsps. Cinnamon

1 1/4 cups of granulated sugar

Method

Unbox each dough tube layer together with cinnamon sugar mix then roll to approx 16 x 12" rectangle

Roll dough rectangle along long edge, keep it taut, cut rolled pastry into 8 - 12 equal pieces so you see the layers, place in greased muffin tin, one last brush of butter and sugar mix on the exposed tops ,

Bake until golden brown 20-25 mins

Cool slightly then remove and roll in leftover sugar/cinnamon mix (if left in tin to cool will seep and stick to pan!)

Other flavours could be used such as ginger, nutmeg, finely diced apples or a cinnamon mix

And enjoy!



FUN FACT; What is a Cruffin?

It's a cross between a croissant and a muffin— first made in 1905 by Bowdens Bakery, Looe. However an Australian claims to have created it first in 2013! A sweet pastry filled with cinnamon, chocolate, many flavours can be used.



A 70th birthday party was held at Treburley Social Club on Saturday 14th June.


A big surprise for Cindy! Many friends and members, from various places came to celebrate. Her family and people came from Scotland and around the South West.

Nature Notes

Red Kites were spotted by Nick Barnes , Trekenner Farm on May 25th 2025
This is quite special, as these marvellous birds of prey are rare. In the early 1930's there were only 2 known breeding pairs in the UK.

How to tell a Red Kite from a buzzard in flight : look for a distinct 'V' shape in the tail and the fact they soar like a kite whereas a buzzard flaps more often.

Their wings are red tipped with black and white feathers and have white patches underneath.

They can typically live for 10 years, and Old English names for them include Puttock, gled and glead.

We'd love to know if you've caught sight of these birds or anything else nature related you'd like to share.

Our next meeting will be on 9th July when one of our own members, Gloria Aze, will be giving us a workshop on "Quilling". This is an attractive (and addictive!) craft which can be used at all times of the year to make special cards for special occasions.

LEZANT WI

There were gasps of delight from members when Graham Parker and Jamie brought along the most beautiful barn owl called Nina. He continually held her on his hand on a glove made of kangaroo skin as he talked about the many types of owls found in this country. Nina is an 8 year old European Barn Owl and Graham had hand reared her from birth. He is from "Show and Tell" and spends much of his time sharing the story of owls with schools and many other groups.

Who knew? Owl's ears are asymmetric. They have such acute hearing that they can hear a mouse's heartbeat anywhere within 30 square feet and rely on hearing when it's dark. The commonest owl is a Tawny Owl and generally that or a Barn Owl or Little Owl are the ones you might see in this area, the Little Owl being half the size of a Tawny Owl. Nina weighs just 13oz and feeds mainly on chicken, refusing to eat a wild Barn Owl's usual diet of mice and voles.

After his talk, everybody had a chance to stroke Nina and feel her incredibly soft feathers and admire her. Linda Watkins was the first to accept the challenge to hold her, then several others did too. What a privilege. A record number of photos were taken as everyone wanted to capture the rare chance of getting this close to such a bird. Nina was held on the left hand, as is traditional in Falconry. In the old days your right hand would then be free to hold your sword.

After refreshments, Alice Brown gave an account of being an observer at the National AGM. It was reported that in the last 12 months there were 22,000 new WI members and 57 newly formed institutes. The new campaign is "Bystanders Can be Lifesavers" to improve public confidence in CPR and defibrillator usage.

A good number entered the competition; an item related to owls. Results 1st Liz Whitley, 2nd Ruth Burden, 3rd Diana Anderson. There was even an owl pellet as an entry.



PARISH TAXI SCHEME—FOR RESIDENTS OF LEZANT PARISH ONLY

If you are a resident of Lezant Parish, you can claim a subsidy for any taxi journey using Launceston Taxis. (Please note: the taxi cannot be used on a regular basis for commuting between home and work, nor as a school-run vehicle.)

From 01 December 2024 the subsidy will be increased to £7 per single journey (you can also claim £7 for the return journey, if applicable). Please note this increase will be for a limited time only in order to use up reserves - once the grant is exhausted the subsidy will be lowered. Please check the magazine for any updates or contact the clerk. To take advantage of the scheme the taxi must be pre-booked through Launceston Taxis on 07340 813434. The taxi driver will have a form that he will complete. You sign the form and pay the reduced rate to the driver. Please note that the single fares quoted below are for guidance only, and may differ depending on where you are being picked up/ dropped off:
