## **NEWS FROM ST BRIOCHUS, LEZANT**





## THE LATE WESLEY COLWILL

Wesley Colwill was born at Withnoe Farm in 1928 and was a well known resident of Lezant Parish for many years. He was a keen photographer, poet and author. He moved to Treburley during the war years and lived at Cresta Park until 1997 when he moved just a few miles away. He died on 30<sup>th</sup> July 2025 aged 97. This is a poem he included in a book that he gave me in 2010.

## **TIMELESS WORLD**

Written by the late Wesley Colwill in October 1996 after he visited Trekenner Mill Bridge near Treburley.

There's music in the woodland, blue sky of summer time, leaves turn and lift as breezes pass, the falling water's chime

Tall purple swaying floppy docks beside the grassy tracks, as nature beckons seeds to grow in moisture laden cracks.

Here cattle graze the river banks, drink from the sparkling rill, a heron calls, shrill mournful sound re-echoing in the hill

Then climb a road hewn from the shelf, where oak and holly grow, in contemplation rest awhile, a timeless world below.

## NATURE NOTES - THE EGG AND THE NAIL VARNISH

Many years ago when we first started conservation breeding, we chose barn owls as our first venture. We had acquired a male in the winter from a serious breeder and in the spring we acquired a young female. Males have absolutely white breasts, females have tiny caramel rosettes set in their white breast. We introduced them, saw they got on and left them for several weeks to ensure a peaceful existence even if it was in captivity. After about 8 weeks, I quietly looked into the nest box and the female was sitting comfortably on several eggs. We had no idea how long she had been sitting. We left it another 3 weeks before looking again. We really had no idea how long she sat due to our leave and save methods. Ultimately, I felt that the eggs had been in the nest longer than the 28 or 29 or 30 days, but was not confident on detail. I decided to take the dirtiest egg from the nest. The female ignored me completely. I had decided to crack the egg on rocks on the side of the Lowley Brook so it could be discarded as food if, as I expected, it was addled. Suddenly, having put a nasty crack in the shell, I heard tiny cheeping inside.

I explained what had happened to my wife and asked her to find some nail varnish while I went to my office to find some old-fashioned typists snowpake. She returned with quite the most outrageous cherry red varnish. I painted the egg to seal it. I then disguised the varnish on the shell with less obvious snowpake.

I put the egg back in the nest. 3 days later a reddish white eggshell appeared in the nest before it was discarded and quite the most beautiful tiny barn owl. She grew up to be a favourite and a wonderful breeder and mother.

N.B. Owls in captivity need to be licenced by an A10 Certificate, registered with DE-FRA. They are never pets.

## PARISH TAXI SCHEME—FOR RESIDENTS OF LEZANT PARISH ONLY

If you are a resident of Lezant Parish, you can claim a subsidy for any taxi journey using Launceston Taxis. (Please note: the taxi cannot be used on a regular basis for commuting between home and work, nor as a school-run vehicle.)

From 01 December 2024 the subsidy will be increased to £7 per single journey (you can also claim £7 for the return journey, if applicable). Please note this increase will be for a limited time only in order to use up reserves - once the grant is exhausted the subsidy will be lowered. Please check the magazine for any updates or contact the clerk. To take advantage of the scheme the taxi must be pre-booked through Launceston Taxis on 07340 813434. The taxi driver will have a form that he will complete. You sign the form and pay the reduced rate to the driver. Please note that the single fares quoted below are for guidance only, and may differ depending on where you are being picked up/ dropped off:

## **LEZANT PARISH ARCHIVE GROUP**


Lezant Parish Archive Group organised a visit to Kresen Kernow on 11th September when seven of us enjoyed a really interesting afternoon. Literally meaning Cornwall Centre, Kresen Kernow is situated on the site of the old Redruth Brewery which has been sympathetically restored to house the Cornwall Archive.

The visit took us to public areas as well as behind the scenes and in the conservation laboratory we saw the tools of the trade and heard some of the amazing stories of seemingly random donations linking up to make up important connections. We were also able to go into the strong rooms where there are 14 miles of shelving.

The icing on the cake was to be able to view seven documents that we prerequested which will add to individual and Parish records. Our thanks to Nigel Jonas for organising the visit and to Tamsin Mallett, Collections and Development Manager at Kresen Kernow, who was our guide for the day. Tamsin gave us a most interesting introduction to the archive building and its history and we learned that the Cornish for Archive is *Argh*, something I often feel like saying!

For anyone interested in using the archive, it is free, is a beautiful building and has a lovely cafe. It is nothing like the archives of old, being light and airy and definitely not musty.
